11 September 2024: OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

In your email dated 11 September 2024, you requested the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA):

- 1. The number of short and feature films written by Pacific women which have been production funded by NZFC in the last 20 years.
- 2. The number of short and feature films directed by Pacific women which have been production funded by NZFC in the last 20 years.
- 3. The number of short and feature films produced by Pacific women which have been production funded by NZFC in the last 20 years.
- 4. The titles of short and feature films written by Pacific women which have been production funded by NZFC in the last 20 years.
- 5. The titles of short and feature films directed by Pacific women which have been production funded by NZFC in the last 20 years.
- 6. The titles of short and feature films produced by Pacific women which have been production funded by NZFC in the last 20 years.
- 7. The number of short films which have been production funded by the NZFC in the last 20 years.
- 8. The number of feature films which have been production funded by the NZFC in the last 20 years.

Data on the number of short and feature films written, directed and produced by Pacific women (in response to parts 1-3 of your request) are set out in **Table 1**.

Gender and ethnicity are self-identified by funding applicants in New Zealand Film Commission (NZFC) funding application forms. The NZFC started requesting demographic data as part of the feature film application process in the 2015-2016 financial year, so please note that we can only include data from this time.

The NZFC started requesting demographic data as part of the short film application process in 2018, so please note we can only provide data from this time.

There are some limitations to the data in **Table 1**, which must be considered when making analysis:

- Due to the sensitivity of demographic information, disclosure of demographic data was, and remains optional. All questions about demographic data include the option of 'prefer not to answer.' Therefore, there are projects that have chosen not to disclose the demographic data of their creative teams and will not be included in the data. For this reason, relevant reporting may include gaps and should be used as an estimate, as it may not reflect the actual demographic spread of the filmmakers supported by the NZFC.
- The data provided in **Table 1** is strictly based on the information that was provided to the NZFC at the time of application. In cases where a creative team has changed after a funding decision is made, the demographic data of the creative team is not updated retrospectively by the NZFC.
- Prior to the 2018-19 financial year, funding applications were received by paper.
 Although a demographic template was provided to applicants, this section had restrictions on how many key creatives could be recorded. This meant that in cases where a project had a large creative team, the demographic information may have been recorded for some, but not all creatives.

Regarding parts 4-6 of your request, this information is withheld under section 9(2)(a) of the OIA, to protect the privacy of natural persons. When requesting demographic data, funding applicants are advised that the NZFC will only report on the data in an anonymised and aggregated manner. This is due to the private, personal and potentially sensitive nature of demographic information. Providing the titles of films will mean that the data is no longer anonymised or aggregated.

In response to parts 7 and 8 of your request, this information can be found in the Appendix of NZFC Annual Reports. NZFC Annual Reports dated back to 2007/08 can be found on the NZFC website here: Corporate Documents (nzfilm.co.nz).

Appendices for Annual Reports dated between 2004-2007 are attached at Appendix 1.

We will be publishing this letter (with your personal information removed) and the appendices on the NZFC website.

Please be aware that you have the right, by way of complaint to an Ombudsman under section 28(3) of the OIA to seek an investigation and review of our response.
